

Perito Moreno Glacier



The Perito Moreno Glacier is located near the town of El Calafate, in the dry and dramatic Patagonian steppe. It is a world-renowned landmark and one of the only glaciers that is still advancing.

You will have the opportunity to explore the glacier first-hand with a private tour and a boat cruise that will take you close enough to fully appreciate the 250 ft tall ice walls.




Iguazu Falls



Experience the unforgettable Iguazu Falls, recently named one of the New Seven Natural Wonders of the world. These spectacular waterfalls drop 269 ft to the river below. Trails through the 210 square mile reserve provide visitors with panoramic views and lower and upper walkways allow you to experience the Falls up-close. An experienced guide will take you off the beaten path and show you the hidden wonders of this unique National Park.





Tierra Del Fuego



Visit the island of Tierra del Fuego where Seacology is funding infrastructure for the majestic Rio Grande Natural Reserve System. Tierra del Fuego is a critical wintering site for several migratory bird species and a designated Important Bird Conservation Area. Despite its protected status, the area is under threat from nearby development. Seacology is helping protect this region by funding signage, bird watching platforms, and educational material to engage the local communities in protecting the reserve.

TRAVEL ITINERARY

- Feb. 14 Arrive in Buenos Aires. Check in to Casa Sur Bellini.
- Feb. 15 Enjoy a private tour of the city. Explore historic neighborhoods. End the day with a traditional dinner and a tango show. Overnight at Casa Sur Bellini.
- Feb. 16 Explore the Argentine countryside and visit the exclusive “El Ombú” Estancia. Overnight at Casa Sur Bellini.
- Feb. 17 Travel to El Calafate, located near the southern tip of Argentina in the dramatic Patagonia steppe. Check in to Hotel Esplendor Calafate.
- Feb. 18 Spend the day exploring the impressive Perito Moreno Glacier. Overnight at Hotel Esplendor Calafate.
- Feb. 19 Day at leisure in El Calafate. Overnight at Hotel Esplendor Calafate.
- Feb. 20 Travel to Rio Grande. Enjoy views of Farango Lake and the Andes Mountains. Check in to Status Hotel Casino.
- Feb. 21 Explore Seacology’s project on Tierra del Fuego Island in Rio Grande. Overnight at Status Hotel Casino.
- Feb. 22 Travel to Iguazu, gateway to the majestic Iguazu Falls. Check in to Amerian Portal de Iguazu.
- Feb. 23 Explore the Argentina side of the Iguazu Falls with a full-day private tour. Overnight at Amerian Portal de Iguazu.
- Feb. 24 Travel to Buenos Aires. Overnight at Casa Sur Bellini.
- Feb. 25 Spend a final day in Buenos Aires. Tour ends. Private transfer to the international airport available.
